CYBER CHARTER SCHOOLS SAVE SCHOOL DISTRICTS MONEY

Cyber Charter Schools save school districts money! For every student that attends a Cyber Charter School, school districts have additional money to support the students that remain within their brick and mortar buildings. On average, Cyber Charter Schools receive just 72% of per pupil allotment for each student. School districts keep the remaining 28% that they can use for payments on debt, adult education programs, pre-K programs, transportation costs, and building and ground maintenance.

CYBER SCHOOLS SUPPORT BRICK AND MORTAR KIDS

Students who remain within their brick and mortar school are benefited by their peers attending a Cyber Charter School. Not only does the School District have more money to spend per pupil, but Cyber Charter Schools serve as a model for innovative virtual education opportunities. Many school districts have started their own cyber programs based on the success of Cyber Charter Schools.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL STUDENTS

Zip codes should not restrict a student's educational opportunities. Cyber Charter Schools provide equal access to high quality teachers, resources, and opportunities regardless of a student's zip code.

CYBER SCHOOLS PROVIDE EQUAL SUPPORTS TO ALL STUDENTS REGARDLESS OF INCOME

Pennsylvania's current funding formula rewards students in wealthy districts over students in poorer school districts providing more educational opportunities to students in wealthy districts. Cyber Charter Schools level the playing field, providing all students with access to high quality resources, certified teachers, and opportunities for engagement regardless of their parents' income.

CYBER SCHOOLS SUPPORT STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS


Cyber Schools support all types of learners from advanced education students to students with high levels of special education needs. Cyber Schools partner with special education providers, therapists, etc. to support the needs of all learners.

EDUCATING THE PUBLIC

Cyber Charter Schools are funded by tax payer dollars. Cyber Charter Schools are committed to ensuring that all parents in Pennsylvania are aware of their choices in public education. Through radio and television advertising, public outreach, social media campaigns, and word of mouth activities, Cyber Charter Schools work to ensure that all parents understand the cyber model and are aware of the opportunities available for every child.

CONTINUED GROWTH

In 1998, the first Cyber Charter School opened in Pennsylvania with 10 students. Now, there are 15 Cyber Charter Schools, expanding opportunities and addressing specific student needs across the commonwealth.



WHO ARE CYBER STUDENTS?

Cyber Schools support students and families in every county and in all school districts. Their populations range from struggling learners to academically advanced students. In many cases, Cyber Schools support a disproportionate number of students with disabilities, students from low income families and students who receive English Language Learners Support.

STUDENT NEEDS CHANGE

As students develop academically, psychologically and socially, their individual needs change. While many students will remain in their Cyber Charter School from Kindergarten through graduation, many students will move in and out of Cyber Charter Schools, brick and mortar charter schools, their local public schools, and even private schools to best meet their individual needs. As such, it is vital to provide equal funding to ensure all students have high quality supports regardless of their choice of school.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

The leadership of Cyber Charter Schools, their faculty, staff and parents continue to collaborate toward advancing opportunities to enhance student outcomes across the commonwealth. As new methods of student assessment and school accountability are developed, the Cyber Charter Schools will continue to address all students individual needs to support educational advancement across the commonwealth.
